Telecommunication and Textile. There are currently more than 2,200 plastic companies operating in Vietnam with the number of domestic enterprises making up 85%.

The plastics sector is aggressively promoted by the Vietnam government as it aims to achieve sufficient supply of home-produced raw material through resin production facilities. In parallel, the government issued a blueprint for developing supporting industries such as mould-making, plastic recycling, chemistry and machinery supply.

By **2020**, domestic plastics producers will need **5 million tonnes** of raw material for manufacturing.
