Global market for seamless pipes and tubes is projected to reach 70.5 million tons by 2020 10.9 billion meters

In 2017, world oil and gas pipe demand will rise 5.3% annually to 51.8 million metric tons



World demand for plastic pipe will rise 6.7% annually through 2019 to 19.3 billion meters
