

Promising outlook for ASEAN's wire, cable, tube and pipe industries





- By 2020, an annual growth in fixed broadband subscribers of 10% or additional 23 million subscribers will be represented
- More operators to roll out or upgrade their existing networks to offer 1Gbit/s services. In Thailand. operators are looking to increase their coverage of high speed broadband services through billion-dollar investments in capital expenditures

Automotive

- Southeast Asia's Motoring Potential
- · Region's growing middle class to more than double to 400 million by 2020
- · Sector has grown at 11% CAGR in the last 5 years
- Dual Carriageway Regional Manufacturing Hub and Local Sales
- Region remains attractive for growth both from local sales to 600 million people, and as a manufacturing hub for regional and global exports
- Thailand and Indonesia leading the drive to be eco-car production and export hubs

Infrastructure













Spending to grow to US\$165 bn by 2025. Most significant growth is in the heavy manufacturing sector, which is expected to grow to US\$46 bn by 2025, driven by expansion of the mining sector





- Spending to grow at 10% a year in the next decade, reaching a total of US\$27 bn a year by 2025
- Growth is expected to be focused on manufacturing, transportation, communications and social infrastructure

- ▶ Spending is to grow by around 9% a vear through to 2025
- Investment growth in the utilities segment is expected to be the most significant, due to comparatively higher need to improve electricity infrastructure





- Spending to top US\$56 bn by 2025 with growth rate of around 9% a year
- Significant investment is expected in the transportation and manufacturing sectors



- Positive outlook for increase in infrastructure investment to reach US\$58.5 bn by 2025
- A high-speed rail project under construction, expected to cost US\$32 bn over 7 years, shall project significant spending in the transportation sector


