For example, on Thursday (5 October), Gaby Köster, who has been in a wheelchair since her stroke in 2008, will read from her novel "Die Chefin" at the forum Living with Care @home. Directly afterwards, the actress and comedienne will answer the questions from the people attending.

Cybathlon Show and Record races will provide a great deal of action: with wheelchairs or robotic exoskeletons, a competition will be held round an obstacle course where the participants have to master certain situations. Navigating stairs and slalom are just two of the many disciplines. The Sport Center also offers many opportunities to enjoy athletics: the complete Hall 7a is dedicated to visitors, who would like to try out different kinds of sports for people with disabilities, be it track and field, table tennis, badminton, archery or numerous other offerings.







# A top-class supporting programme

There is always much going on at REHACARE. With a tour through the exhibition halls, you will come across forums or theme parks; you can listen to lectures or visit seminars. The range on offer leaves nothing to be desired:

Four days long at the **REHACARE Forum**, various topics will be treated. These topics deal with questions regarding everyday life of affected people, participation and inclusion, provision of aids and much more. Furthermore, interesting, innovative products will be presented.

The forum Living with Care @home discusses several aspects of diseases amongst elderly people and the need for medical care resulting from this. During four days, the event is dedicated to issues with regard to wounds, dementia, palliative medicine and exercise that arise for nursing relatives and nursing services concerning the subject of medical care at home.
