Plastics in the Region

- Southeast Asia's plastics market is expected to register a CAGR of 5.5% through to 2023
- The Asia Pacific purging compound market is likely to expand at the fastest CAGR over the next few years because of growing demand from economies including China, India and Japan
- ☐ Thailand and the region are embracing salient issues relating to:
 - Fuel efficiency through development of their very own electric vehicle industry
 - Plastics waste reduction through a recycling infrastructure
 - Adoption of smart manufacturing via Industry 4.0 initiatives



Riding the Wave of Thailand 4.0

- Thailand is projected to become the 7th largest economy by 2030
- Thailand has invested more than US\$60 million in bioplastics development in recent years
- Healthcare spending is expected to grow at 8%, propelling the consumption for medical and pharmaceutical plastics in the sector
- Thailand has grown to become one of the biggest automotive hubs in Southeast Asia. The Thai government plans to increase tire production to I million tonnes per year
- Electronics remain the main exported product, combining with electrical appliances to make up 31% of total exports, resulting in a significant increase in plastics consumption
- Plastic packaging industry accounts for 48% of Thailand's plastic consumption
